



NEW BOOKS! How many new books?? Almost 5 feet of new books thanks to the Friends of the Alden Library and the Pilcrow Foundation. Pictured are some of our favorites!

The Dr. Grace O. Doane Alden Public Library recently applied and received the Children's Book Project grant through the Pilcrow Foundation. The Pilcrow Foundation is an organization dedicated to providing new, quality, hardcover children's books to rural public libraries.

The Pilcrow Foundation provides a 2-to-1 match to rural public library grant recipients who contribute \$400 through Friends of the Library or other local sponsors. The purchases of the Alden Public Library grant books worth over \$1800-was made possible by a \$400 sponsorship provided by the Friends of the Alden Public Library. This qualified our library to receive 82 books from the Pilcrow Foundation geared to ages preschool through junior high. The library was also delighted to receive more than \$400 in additional math and science books from Mr. Hal Berenson and Mrs. Laura Ackerman of Colorado, 17 books related to health and wellness by a generous donation from Drs. Bill Strawbridge and Meg Wallhagen of California, along with two books from Syncretic Press funded by an anonymous donor for a total of 123 new books.
